

## HASA Volunteer Descriptions

**Seafood Festival** - Our second largest fundraiser of the year. Chairpersons and committee is responsible for planning and ordering food and supplies, setting up/breaking down the booth, general logistics, and managing volunteer sign ups and duties.

**Silent Auction** - Our biggest fundraiser of the year. Chairpersons and committee is responsible for putting together a fun night out for parents and friends of the school. Tasks include sending out invitations, soliciting and organizing auction items, planning the menu, setting up the venue, and sending thank you notes for all donations afterwards.

**Hot Lunch** - There are several levels to this committee. One volunteer orders the food from local restaurants, one is in charge of lining up volunteers to serve every day of the week, and one keeps up with the supplies. Many parents sign up to serve hot lunch to the students (whether it be 1 time a week or 1 time a month). Time commitment is a little over an hour to set up and serve lunch, occasionally picking up food from the restaurants.

**Hospitality** - The committee is responsible for bringing in gifts and goodies for HASA various social events throughout the year.

**Yearbook** - The chairperson and committee is responsible for creating the beautiful, hardbound annual yearbook. Responsibilities include coordinating with our publisher, collecting book orders, simple graphic designing and layout, taking pictures, and selling ads.

**Curriculum Enrichment** - This committee finds and schedules various groups to enrich our student's education with science or cultural arts events throughout the year.

**Walk-a-thon**- Chairperson and committee is responsible for organizing supplies, music and volunteer stations during this fun spring event which raises scholarship funds for qualified Catholic and Non-Catholic students.
